To commemorate women authors who wrote inspirational books in Canadian history, I used the shape of an open book as the basic format of my piece.

I associate literature with printed books. Subtle etching of information such as book titles and biographical excerpts provides the background texture. The choice of photo etching is very appropriate since it references the zinc plates used in offset printing. Many readers still prefer the tactile touch and turning of pages to digital forms.

To celebrate exceptional female authors, I made some names visible. Names float over the top of the pages and are reflected when a lit candle is in the holder.

The different typefaces used for each name were chosen for the visual interest these provide as well as to illustrate the many genres in literature.
